Mosaic Art

The art of creating images by assembling small pieces of stone, glass, paper, or other materials...

DIRECTIONS:

- Sketch out ideas for your composition. At least 3 different ideas and/or the same idea composed in 3 different ways. Come up with something original and unique! Try to avoid a single subject in the middle, and instead think of a more creative way to utilize the space.
- Complete a contour drawing (basic outline of shapes, sections, and edges) of your composition on the your 12 x 18 drawing paper
- Begin tearing and/or cutting pieces of magazines and/or newspaper based on the color and section you are working on first
 - a. The <u>should not be any smaller than a quarter</u> each, and relatively so for any long skinny strips of paper you use
 - b. You <u>must use at least two different shapes</u> of pieces (ie" small squares and short strips)
 - c. Optional: Lightly write in the colors for each main section of the drawing
- 4. Glue each individual piece to the appropriate section
 - a. Pieces should overlap and/or be uniformly spaced
 - b. Make sure to create contrast to define edges in your composition
- 5. Once you complete a section, continue onto another section of color

6. Continue filling the spaces with your small pieces, until you <u>cover the white of the</u> paper entirely!
