- <u>Seminar Students:</u> Media of choice. Option to expand upon previous Self-Portrait Assignment or create your own alternative theme to apply to concept of "Past, Present, & Future...."
- Begin by brainstorming, sketching, and collecting images of objects, subjects, relationships, and/or words that you connect with in these different times in your life. Consider whether you see these as distinct and separate, or continuous and weaved together... or both ©
