Plagiarism, Academic Honesty, Ethics, and the Honor Code

This course will be conducted with a strong emphasis on and adherence to **ethics**. The production of art which is not original or created from copies of others' works will result in a zero grade or credit. All students will be expected to do his/her own work with the majority of the art making being done IN CLASS. Any work that makes use of other artists' work (including photographs) and/or published images must show substantial and significant development beyond duplication, meaning that without a doubt your own artistic voice is apparent and predominant. This may be demonstrated through manipulation of the formal qualities, design, and/or concept of the original work. Remember that it is unethical, constitutes plagiarism, and often violates copyright law simply to copy an image (even in another medium) that was made by someone else).
