

Self-portrait/Identity Acrylic on Cardboard

DIRECTIONS:

1. Explore ideas about Identity and what it means to be you. (Separate brainstorming activity)
2. Sketch out ideas for your composition. At least 3 different ideas and/or the same idea composed in 3 different ways.
3. Prepare your surface by painting a field of color that covers most or all of a piece of cardboard. This can be:
 - a. a gradient of dark to light/light to dark
 - b. one color into another
 - c. flat field of color
4. Manipulate the cardboard surface further, by cutting and peeling and integrating the contrasting corrugated and smoother textures
3. Create a light pencil outline of your composition on your prepared surface
