VALUE SCALES, TINTS, & SHADES

GRAYSCALE: A range of gray shades from white to black. <u>REMINDER</u>: it is always better to add small amounts of a darker color to a lighter color, rather than wasting a ton of a lighter color to try to lighten the darker color.

TINT: created when you mix a color with white. <u>REMINDER</u>: Always begin with white and add a bit of color to the white until the desired tint is obtained.

SHADE: Created when you mix a color with black. <u>REMINDER</u>: Always begin with the color and add just a bit of black at a time to get the desired shade of a color. Too much black can guickly overpower any color
